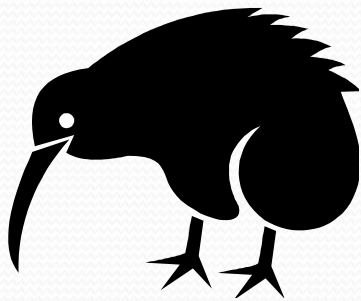


Kiwi Enrichment Feature

Kiwi Enrichment



- Use piles of leaves and mulch for kiwi to dig through
- Rotting logs allow for foraging of insects
- Some kiwi like live crayfish, baby eels
- Think 3-D! Kiwi like to climb, so add logs, piles of soil
- Make sure your soil is soft enough for probing, kiwi spend hours every night probing
- Kiwi like water: Did you know kiwi can swim?
